WELCOME - WELLING TOWN FC

ood afternoon everyone and welcome back to the Stanmore Group Stadium for a second local derby in five days.

This afternoon we welcome the players, offiials and supporters of Welling Town Football Club who have made the short journey to Bayliss Avenue.

Our visit there in October saw us win 6-0, but the Boots have had some decent performances, and victories, when visiting in the past so we need to respect them.

Whatever the outcome today, we wish them well for the remainder of the campaign.

We are also delighted to welcome officials from our chosen charity MIND, who are here as part of their 'Time to Talk' Day.

They will be here with leaflets and will be very visible, so please reach out to them if you, or a loved one, are struggling with mental health issues. We are very proud to be associated with the fantastic work that MIND do.

Tuesday night saw us pick up a very late point in a 1-1 draw at home to League leaders Glebe. It was a very tight game that looked like going Glebe's way until Jake Lovell burst through to level with seconds remaining of the seven minutes of added time.

That came after our opponents had a goal disallowed for offside a few minutes earlier. To everyone in the ground it

looked like we got away with one on that occasion, but you have to take your luck. From our point of view it was a well earned point after we built up the pressure as the game went on.

Everyone in our camp was delighted for Jake who scored his first competitive goal for the club. Let's hope it will give him the confidence to start finding the net regularly, as he did for previous club Greenways at the start of the season.

Taking out the penalties at Hilltop, we are unbeaten in four games now, but need to start converting some of draws into wins as we look to get into one of the play-off places at the end of the season.

After today we have a free week before travelling to Holmesdale in the League Cup quarter-finals next Saturday.

We hope that you will be able to make the trip to support the team as they look to make a second semi-final this season.

Our next home game is the visit of Kennington on Tuesday 13th.

Harry Taylor missed the Glebe game in midweek with a knee injury, but is hoping to be available today.

We also offer a belated welcome to Ted Green who has joined the squad to give us competition at left-back and made his debut in the Kent Senior Trophy game against Snodland Town.

HISTORY - WELLING TOWN



ounded as recently as 2014, Welling
Town FC started out as a Sunday side
playing on a Council pitch at Hall Place,
Bexley in the London and Kent Suburban
League.

Achieving two promotions in as many seasons, the club then expanded to include a second Sunday side with both playing in the Woolwich and Eltham Sunday Football Alliance.

The move to Saturday football was inevitable and they theyre accepted in to the Kent County Football League in the summer of 2016 despite having no past playing record in Saturday regional football on the basis of their good Sunday record, excellent conduct and professional setup demonstrating ambition and organisation beyond many sides at that level.

Their debut season in 2016/17 saw them win promotion and the West Kent Challenge Shield beating four teams from higher divisions in the process - their first ever silverware.

Their 2017/18 season was extraordinary – winning the Kent County Second Division, as well as defending their West Kent Challenge Shield. However, the real peak of the season was winning the Kent Junior Cup, a competition with over 160 entrants, ranking them as the top amateur side in Kent. A rare treble had been achieved, scoring over 130 goals in the process, and losing just one match in 53, over a 21 month period.

Meanwhile, their success on the field, had been mirrored by an application off the field to the FA to move in to the semi-professional ranks for 2018/19. After many months of paperwork, calls and meetings, the agonising wait was over, and they were approved for membership of the Southern Counties East Football League First Division, Step 6 of the

non-league pyramid, for the new season ahead.

Not wanting to have gone to such lengths in gaining entry just to make up the numbers, they were determined to prove their worth and be up towards the top of the table pushing for another trophy and promotion. Gaining a huge points advantage early in the season and setting the early pace, they were slowly clawed back as others made up their games in hand, but a strong run in the last two months of the season ensured another historic title win, lifting the Southern Counties East First Division title at the first time of asking, and therefore promotion to their Premier Division for 2019/20. As a result of their new found level they were also drawn in both the FA Vase and FA Cup for the season ahead.

During 2019/20 they made their debuts in the FA Cup losing at the first hurdle to AFC Uckfield, as well as the FA Vase, where they faired better winning four ties before being eliminated by Chatham Town in a 1-0 away defeat in the 3rd Round proper – in front of nearly 300 people.

Their debut league season in the SCEFL Premier started well with an eight game unbeaten run from September through November 2019, including cup games, and saw a significant unbeaten run and a strong top 6 position, before a poorer run from December until the Covid-19 lockdown ended the season prematurely, with the curtailed season leaving them in a highly commendable 9th place above many established sides with decades of history at this level.

Following a disjointed period for the club and football in general due to Covid-19 they briefly topped the table at the start of the 2020/21 season having won all of their first four league games, before that season was

too curtailed with them sitting in mid-table.

2021/22 started with a new groundshare at Kent Football United's Efes Stadium and after a difficult start they finished the season strongly ending up in 14th place in their first completed season at SCEFL Premier Division level (Step 5).

Spring of 2022 saw an agreement put in place to move into a groundshare with Chatham Town at their Bauvill Stadium, one of the best facilities at this level of non-league football, to create an exciting future for the first team on the field and give them the environment to continue pushing towards further success.

At the same time a Development side was accepted in to the new SCEFL mid-week league offering a better pathway for the club to develop its own players in conjunction with the long-term working relationship alongside Charlton Athletic Community Trust. An additional side at Under 16 level also joined the club.

Ending the 22/23 season just above the relegation zone, an exciting opportunity to take on as many as 20 youth sides from the now defunct K Sports Youth means they'll field sides across almost all age-groups from senior mens to under 7s for the season ahead, as well as mid-week development football, and Sunday adults. Their continued working relationship with CACT means there is a clear pathway for footballers who excel from Under 13 Kent Youth League all the way to Under 18, as well as Junior Premier League, Kent County and the SCEFL Development League, all supporting their SCEFL Premier Division men's side.

Welling Town have therefore progressed from recreational Sunday football in the park, to semi-professional football in stadiums, in a little over three years, including numerous promotions, title wins and cup victories along the way, and they're told moving from one to the other in such a short period is unique, and they now play at their highest ever level, and have more players and club members than at any point.

SCEFL - ROUND-UP



wo late goals saw Faversham
Town fend off opponents Deal
Town in second place on Tuesday
night.

Aaron Millbank scored either side of half-time as Deal looked to follow up their recent 4-2 win at Faversham.

The game turned when Deal substitute Wes Hennessey was sent off in the 80th minute.

Sam Hasler scored his third in two games in the 87th minute to give Faversham hope and Kieron Campbell completed the comeback a minute later.

There were two other 2-2 draws, with Corinthian twice coming from behind to claim a point at Stansfeld.

Reiss Skeen's penalty on the stroke of half-time put the hosts ahead, and he restored the lead following Luke Adams' 68th minute equaliser.

It wasn't to be for Stansfeld as Oscar Housego levelled three minutes from time.

Lydd Town also fell behind twice before claiming Scott Porter's first point since taking over, as they drew at Tunbridge Wells.

Trevor McCreadie gave Wells a first half lead that was cancelled out by Sam Adams' 65th minute penalty.

Parity was short-lived as Mike Astle put the hosts ahead two minutes later, but Troy Howard stepped up to rescue a point in the 90th minute.

After losing 6-1 at home to Bearsted last Saturday, Holmesdale bounced back with a 4-0 win at Hollands & Blair.

Wale Odedoyin put the Dalers ahead in the sixth minute, with Sam Bayford doubling their advantage before half-time.

Odedoyin's second put the result beyond reasonable doubt before Tony Musoke completed a good night for Andy Constable's side.

Kennington eased their relegation worries with a 2-0 win at home to fellow strugglers Sutton Athletic.

Fin Dent's 9th minute opener put them on their way, with Ryan Philpott scoring from the spot early in the second half.

Out-of-form Fisher overcame travel problems getting out of London, caused by the train strike, to win 2-1 at Rusthall.

Jesse Hammond gave the hosts a 14th minute lead, but second half goals from Tyron Mbuenimo and Teddy Jones saw the Fish to victory as Rusthall remained in the bottom two.






