For entertainment and drama, it is hard to think of many better games than our League Cup semi-final 2nd leg last week.

When Deal took a 3-1 aggregate lead we faced an uphill task, but such was the sheer bloody-mindedness of the players, it was no surprise when we came back to level the tie at 3-3.

Perhaps more surprising was that Jerome Jayaguru slammed in an unstoppable goal and Tom Ash put us ahead on the night.

With 21 games unbeaten, Deal were never going to give up easily and restored their aggregate lead.

Step forward James Dyer to make it nine goals in seven games before James Miles ended a flowing move to win the tie in the 89th minute.

Everyone was delighted for Milo who has been a great servant for the past two years and could make his 100th appearance for the Dockers tonight.

We now face a tough Final against Corinthian on Good Friday. For now we have to put that to one side as we continue the pursuit of a play-off place.

This evening we welcome our old rivals and friends from Fisher Football Club in what is the third attempt to play the match.

We hope their, players, officials and loyal supporters enjoy their trip and we wish them all the best after tonight's game.

After an excellent start to the season, they have suffered a poor run of form, but it would folly to be complacent about our task this evening.

Unfortunately the weather put paid to Saturday's trip to Stansfeld which becomes another game to fit into a busy calendar.

On Saturday we travel to Hollands & Blair in the League, before the second of three successive Tuesday evening home games when Snodland Town visit us.

Tonight is the first of five home games in March, and they will go a long way to deciding our play-off chances, so please get behind the team as they look to build on an exciting season.

HISTORY - FISHER FC

riginally formed in 1908, the Fish have a chequered history, including the highs of taking on Bristol City in the 1st round of the FA Cup in 1984, playing Conference Football, and towards the end of Fisher Athletic, winning the London Senior Trophy.

The final few years of the old Fisher Athletic turned sour as the ground was lost and finally, in 2009 (five years after moving in with Dulwich Hamlet), the club was wound up by the high court.

A week later, following a successful meeting, a supporter's trust was set up to take control of the club.

Renamed Fisher FC and continuing to play at Dulwich's Champion Hill, the club entered the Kent League and finished their debut season in 13th under the guidance of Gary Lisney.

Various managers (including Billy Walton, Martin Ford and Steve Firkins) came and went in the following seasons, bringing varying levels of success to the club (most notably reaching the Semi-Finals of the Kent League Cup under Billy Walton in 2013-14, eventually losing 6-4 on aggregate to Beckenham, who went on to win the competition).

In December 2014, former Beckenham assistant manager Dean Harrison (the mastermind behind Becks' 2014 League Cup and Kent Senior Trophy double crown) took the reins.

He brought with him a host of new faces and achieved the main task of retaining SCEFL status with four games to spare, some impressive performances against more established sides turning more than a few heads along the way. The club returned home to Rotherhithe just in time for the start of the 2016-17 season, with Gary Abbott taking over following Harrison's surprise departure in the summer.

Abbott struggled to get things going on the field and was relieved of managerial duties in November. The club moved quickly to bring Harrison back to the dugout for the survival fight.

Despite a valiant effort, the club were relegated to SCEFL Division 1, and finished third in 2017-18 season.

After finishing outside the promotion spots the club were awarded promotion by the FA Leagues Committee, and were back in the SCEFL Premier Division for the 2018-19 season.

A superb first season back at Step 5 saw the Fish finish 3rd in the league, having sat at the top of the tree mid-season. The club also reached the Semi-Final of the SCEFL Challenge Cup, and the Quarter Final of the Kent Senior Trophy.

Another shock departure from Harrison has seen the majority of that squad picked off to move on.

After a brief spell under the leadership of Allan Fenn at the beginning of the 2019/20 campaign, Ajay Ashanike took charge and steadied the ship before the Pandemic brought the season to a premature end.

A very short 2020/21 Season provided them with a run in the Emirates FA Cup that saw them beat Horsham YMCA, then Tooting & Mitcham via a dramatic tie settled on penalties to set up a trip to Cray Wanderers, which saw them lose 3-1. With things finally back to normal, the 2021-22 Season saw them finish their SCEFL campaign in 13th place. While success didn't come on the pitch in the cups, they enjoyed a night to remember against Brentford's B team in the London Senior Cup. The Bees won 2-0 as Fisher set a new record home attendance of 425.

The 2022-23 Season brought much in the way of cup success, including a record breaking run in the Emirates FA Cup, reaching the 2nd Qualifying Round and taking National League South side Welling United to a replay before bowing out in front of a record St Paul's crowd of 573.

A 59 game season was brought to a close with the Final of the SCEFL Challenge Cup, which saw them fall to a narrow defeat 2-1 against Hollands & Blair.

The 2023-24 Season brings fresh hope and several new faces as we look to build on last season's achievements.

It completed a successful week for Michael Golding's side after a 2-2 draw at AFC Whytleafe last Tuesday, saw them join us in the SCEFL Challenge Cup Final, winning 5-2 on aggregate.

Deal Town moved above Faversham Town into third spot after a 3-0 win at VCD Athletic.

The visitors had to be patient before Billy Munday opened the scoring in the 76th minute.

Tom Chapman added the second five minutes later with Wes Hennessey netting in the final minute.

Snodland Town kept their play-off hopes alive with a 5-2 win at home to Fisher last Wednesday evening.

Francis Babalola and Nathaniel

Olowale gave the hosts a 2-0 lead at half-time before Sam Sene-Richardson pulled on back for the Fish in the 53rd minute.

Taylor Fisher restored Snodland's two goal advantage midway through the second-half only for Eni Amgbaduba to make it 3-2 eighteen minutes from time.

The visitor's hopes of a point were dashed as Fisher completed his hattrick with two further goals.

AFC Whyteleafe's march towards the Division One title continued with a 2-0 win at home to K Sports.

The game was heading for a draw until Taurean Roberts scored in the 89th minute and Adam Allen scored a minute later to give the Leafe a fourteen point lead.

Second placed Staplehurst Monarchs have two games in hand, but lost ground after a goalless draw at Meridian VP.

Canterbury City's play-off chances appear to be receding after they lost 2-1 at Faversham Strike Force.


Tom Barton gave Force the lead early in the second half, with Brooke Tiernan bagging an 85th minute winner after Monty Saunders equalised for City.


