G ood evening everyone and welcome to the Stanmore Group Stadium as we play our third cup tie in a row.

This evening it is the SCEFL Challenge Cup that takes centre stage as we welcome the players, officials and supporters of Rusthall for our third round tie.

We have already beaten the Rustics here in the League this season, but that counts for nothing this evening as both sides look for a quarter-final place.

We have already reached the last eight of the Kent Senior Trophy after our 2-0 win at home to Fisher ten days ago.

After a goalless first half it was Tom Ash who put us ahead from close range early in the second half.

Joe Chalker sealed the win with a lovely finish midway through the second half.

So for the second year in a row we are through to the last 32 of the competition.

These are times to savour for the club and while we didn't know our opponents at the time of these notes, we have to go into the next round believing we can progress further.

The fourth round will be on Saturday 13th January, meaning our scheduled League fixture at home to Snodland Town is postponed.

We now have four home games to rearrange for later in the season.

We are back here again on Saturday, when Hollands & Blair are our visitors in the SCEFL Premier Division.

As always, your support for the team would be greatly appreciated.

he club were first registered with the Kent County Football Association on June 17th 1899 when they joined the newly formed Tunbridge Wells League.

The "Rustics" first success came in 1905 when the league was won in convincing style. The 1920's saw the club up among the best locally with the Kent Junior Cup Group 'A' being won in 1924. They were champions of the Tunbridge Wells League in 1923, 1924, 1925, 1926 and again in 1930.

The success continued through the 1930's with more league titles and another Kent Junior Cup in 1935.

The Rustics were unable to continue these successes after the War.

There were lean times for the club and in the 1970's the club were close to folding but just managed to keep going largely thanks to the hard work of then secretary Peter Smith with just one side in the Tonbridge League.

The 1980's saw an influx of new young players, and in 1982 the club won Division One of the Tonbridge League.

At this point Derek Seal took on the roll of Chairman. One of his first tasks was to get the club into the Kent Amateur (now Kent County) League and the club lifted the Division Two Title at the first attempt in 1983-84. season with the Division One title secured on the last day of the season with a 1-0 win at Paddock Wood. After several embarrassing incidents at the Council-owned Southwood Road recreation ground the club obtained the use of a field at Jockey Farm in the village.

After a lot of hard work by the committee the ground met the League's ground grading criteria for Intermediate football. By now the club were running three senior sides.

An amalgamation with Rusthall Boys FC was a big step in making the club what it is today, the Rustics currently run three men's teams and close to 20 youth teams from Under 6 through to Under 18.

Work at Jockey Farm continues apace as the club strive to improve facilities, and a Directors lounge is now up and running and has been named the Derek Seal Suite in memory of the late Chairman who originally had the idea to build a ground at Jockey Farm.

As soon as the 2016-17 season finished, contractors moved in, levelled the pitch, installed new drainage and the whole area was reseeded.

A new 125-seater stand has now been installed, named in memory of former President Bob Woodhams, along with a new fence and path installed on the far side of the ground along with new

dugouts, and both dressing rooms have also been refurbished. The ground will now be called The Jockey Farm Stadium.

All this has been achieved by a small group of dedicated volunteers as the club strive to achieve their motto...

"TO BE THE BEST FOOTBALL CLUB POSSIBLE"

In the 2016/17 Season Rusthall finished in second place in the SCEFL First Division. That meant promotion to the Premier where the following year they luckily held onto their place at that level despite finishing in 19th place.

The following season there was no such luck though as another 19th position saw the club relegated to the First Division.

A quick return was only denied by the Coronovirus Pandemic - where the season was declared null and void with the Club in an excellent position for promotion.

With the same happening again in 2020/21 the FA chose to combine results from the two unfinished seasons to reward the best performers and this meant they were granted promotion and a place back in the Premier Division for the 2021/22 campaign.

Relegation was narrowly averted in their first year back at Step Five but 2022/23 provided them with an excellent 6th placed finish.

They now go into 2023/24 excited by what is in store for their Club.

SCEFL - ROUND-UP



t was a successful day in the FA Vase, as all three SCEFL sides involved progressed to the 4th round in away ties.

Deal Town, winners in 2000, won 2-0 away at Lingfield with Rory Smith and Aaron Millbank scoring either side of half-time.

Holmesdale had a tough trip to Eastbourne United, but took a 29th minute lead from Sam Bayford's penalty.

Harvey Mapstone levelled three minutes into the second half for the hosts and it stayed 1-1 before Holmesdale won 5-4 on penalties.

News of yesterday's draw will be in Saturday's programme.

Faversham Town returned to the top of the League after a 3-1 win at Kennington on Friday night.

Two Billy Bennett goals put them in control before Keiron Campbell added a third on the stroke of half-time.

Finn Dent pulled one back in the second half for Kennington, who remain bottom of the table.

Glebe looked like returning to the top as they led 3-1 at Rusthall on Saturday, only for the referee to abandon the game due to fog descending on Jockey Farm.

Whitstable Town went above us in third spot after a 4-0 win at Lordswood.

Despite leading Lordswood to their best start in recent seasons, manager Matt Barman resigned last Wednesday, and they made the worst possible start on Saturday, conceding a goal in the third minute from Harvey Smith.

Josh Oliver added a second in the 54th minute before Josh Williams struck twice.

Snodland Town missed the chance to go sixth after a 1-1 draw at Hollands & Blair.

Francis Babalola gave Snodland a 40th minute lead and it looked like being enough before Harvey Welford scored six minutes from time.

Fisher's flying start has faded and they went down 2-1 to Welling Town who eased their relegation worries.

Max Manktelow put the Boots ahead in the first half with Seb Rowland added a second after the break.

An own goal twenty minutes from time gave the Fish hope but they failed to find an equaliser.

Bearsted are still on the fringes of the playoff race and helped their cause with a 2-1 win at Lydd Town.

Ollie Freeman and Will Johnson-Cole put the Bears in control despite James Rogers bagging a late consolation.

VCD Athletic are finding victories hard to come by and twice conceded the lead in a 2-2 draw at home to Punjab United.

Rochester United scored five times in a thirteen minute spell either side of half-time as they won 8-0 away to K Sports.


Max Morgan scored on the stroke of halftime and completed his hat-trick with two more in the opening four minutes of the second half.






