# **WELCOME - FAVERSHAM TOWN FC**

elcome to the Stanmore Group Stadium for the first of four successive home games in twelve days.

This evening we welcome the players, officials and supporters of Faversham Town Football Club.

Like us, Faversham are chasing promotion and we have known all season that this will be a key fixture.

The Dockers' won a seven-goal thriller at Salters Lane in November, coming from 0-2 down at half-time to win 4-3.

Two games in the last twelve days yielded the maximum six points and pushed us up into fifth spot.

The team are in fantastic form and have grown in maturity and resilience in recent weeks.

There is still a quarter of the League campaign to play after this evening, so while we should enjoy the games and moments, no one should be getting carried away.

Last Tuesday we enjoyed a 5-2 win at home to Fisher. Being honest, it was a flattering scoreline for a game where we went behind twice and really didn't get going until Jake Lovell's superb effort levelled.

The last eleven minutes really showed what confidence can do.

Once we went 3-2 up we looked like scoring with every attack, while Fisher crumbled.

Saturday we faced what is always a tough away game at Hollands & Blair. After an even first half, Harry Taylor's header gave us the lead in added time.

Having equalised nineteen minutes from time, Blair really tested us, but Ollie Milton managed to squeeze a second goal inside the post, before Harry scored a tap in with the last kick of the game to make it 3-1.

It is the first time we have visited Star Meadow since the they redeveloped the ground, and they should be complemented on a superb job.

We will be back at Hollands & Blair as they will be hosting the SCEFL Challenge Cup Final on Good Friday.

The game will kick-off at 1pm.

# HISTORY - FAVERSHAM TOWN 🧱

aversham Town F.C. are a semi-professional football club competing in the Southern **Counties East Football League** (SCEFL), with U23s development, FTFC post 16 Football Academy and with youth teams at all ages.

They also run girls' teams, disability teams and a powerchair team. Faversham Town are the only club in the country other than England to boast a Three Lions badge, proudly representing the town crest.

Faversham Town's origins go back to 1884, initially playing friendlies before entering the Kent League around the turn of the century.

The club disbanded for the Second World War but reformed in 1947 as the Faversham Town we know today with their 'lilywhite' shirts. The following year, the club moved to their current Salters Lane home.

Having started in the Kent League, they were founder members of the Aetolian League in 1959-60 when the Kent League folded. Four years later the Aetolian merged with the London League to become the Greater London League.

When the Kent League reformed in 1966-67 they switched back and in 1969-70 they lifted the League title for the first time. Twelve months later the club retained the title and completed

a double as they also won the League Cup.

The following season, 1971-72, the club moved again, this time to the Metropolitan London League, finishing runners-up in our first season.

In 1972-73 the Lilywhites joined the Athenian League for the first of three seasons, before returning to the Kent League once more.

The League title was won for the third time in the decade as it returned to Salters Lane in 1977-78. They completed the double by lifting the Kent Senior Trophy for a second successive season. In 1989-90 the Kent League was won for a fourth time.

Two more top half finishes followed before a decade of struggle saw the club fold in 2003 amid financial difficulties. The stadium became derelict and vandalised, but a strong desire by supporters and businessmen in the town to save their local team led to its revival in 2005. Volunteers hacked back shoulderhigh grass and renovated the stands, and the club rose from the ashes.

Town won promotion to the Kent League in the first season back in 2005/06. In 2009-10 they were crowned Kent League Champions and took the massive step up to the semiprofessional Isthmian League, the highest level in the club's long history. To complete a memorable season, the Kent Senior Trophy was won for a third time.

The club finished third in 2012-13. earning a chance of promotion via the play-offs. After beating Hythe Town 3-0 at home in the semi-final, the club lost by the same scored at Maidstone United, who took their place in the Premier Division.

Two seasons later in 2014-15 the Lilywhites finished third again to earn another crack at the Premier Division via the play-offs. Once again they suffered heartache, losing 5-4 on penalties to Merstham following a 0-0 draw at Salters Lane in the semi-final.

A fifth place finish in 2015-16 saw a third play-off campaign in four seasons. Having won 2-1 at Dorking Wanderers, they were beaten 3-0 at Worthing in the Final. The club failed to reach those heights again and suffered the heartbreak of relegation last season despite bringing Sammy Moore in from Potters Bar Town midseason.

In January Sammy was relieved of his duties after a disappointing run, with Tommy Warrilow appointed. With great experience at Tonbridge Angels who he guided to the National League South and Ashford United, they are looking forward to a bright future.

# **SCEFL - ROUND-UP**



eal Town's FA Vase run ended in Saturday's quarter-final with a penalty shoot out defeat at Lincoln United.

The tie ended 1-1 at 90 minutes, with Lincoln winning 4-3 on penalties.

Jack McMenemy gave the hosts a 15th minute lead, with Tom Chapman levelling two minutes before the break for Deal.

In the League, Glebe continue to keep the pressure on the chasing pack at the top of the table.

They completed a double over Bearsted with a 2-0 win at Foxbury Avenue with Jamie Philpot scoring in each half.

Corinthian lost ground after a goalless draw at home to Snodland Town who ended the game with nine men after Jack Bath and George Monger were both sent off for second yellow cards.

Whitstable Town's play-off hopes were dealt a massive blow as they lost 4-0 at home to Fisher, who had lost five of their previous six games.

Jacob Katonia opened the scoring five minutes before half-time with Flavio Jumo, Nathan Tshola and Michael Sarpong piling on the agony in the second half for the Oystermen who have dropped to eighth with only eight games to play. At the bottom, Rusthall's plight looks increasingly worrying after a 2-0 defeat at VCD Athletic.

Ironically the game marked the debut of Steadman Callender, who moved from VCD to Rusthall in midweek, but it was Richard Jimoh who took the plaudits with both of Vickers' goals.

Kennington moved further towards safety after coming from behind to win 2-1 at Holmesdale.

Veron Parkes gave the Dalers an 18th minute lead, but Ryan Philpott and Harry Linch scored either side of the break to turn the game around.

Matt Gething put Lordswood ahead on his return to former club Tunbridge Wells, but his day was to end with a 3-2 defeat.

Trevor McCreadie scored twice, either side of a Regan Corke goal before Jacob Strouts grabbed a late consolation goal.

Lydd Town kept their play-off chances alive with a 3-0 win at Sutton Athletic.

Robbie Dolan gave them a 4th minute lead, with Troy Howard and Sam Adams scoring in the final two minutes of the first half.




