WELCOME - TUNBRIDGE WELLS FC

Good evening everyone and welcome back to the Stanmore Group Stadium for the visit of Tunbridge Wells Football Club.

A warm welcome to our visitors who are one of only two teams we have faced in every season since we joined the Kent League at the end of the last century.

They are the only side we have yet to face in the League this season, with the return fixture coming up in April.

Saturday saw us suffer the disappointment of our first League defeat in seven games as we lost 3-2 to Faversham Town. Conceding so late made it even harder to take.

There was another great attendance on Saturday, with 182 fans here.

The consequence is that the race for the play-off places has really opened up, right down to Punjab United in tenth place.

We have always maintained that this would be the case but there is lots of football to be played between now and the end of April.

It promises to be very exciting and we hope that you will be with us every step of the way.

Our game against Snodland Town, which was postponed last week, will now be played on Thursday 25th April and will be our last game of the season

as we don't have a fixture on the last Saturday.



This coming Saturday is Non-League Day as we welcome Whitstable Town.

We are hoping for another great turn out and are offering season ticket holders of Premier League or EFL clubs admission for £5 on production of their tickets, so please spread the word.

One of our first time visitors on Saturday put a great review on X and it is always great for us to read.

We follow that game with the visit of Holmesdale next Tuesday.

That is the last game before the League Cup Final on Good Friday.

Ticket details are on the Club News page, but please note admission will be **CASH ONLY** on the day. You will be able to use your card in the bar however.

Let's get behind the boys tonight as they look to start another unbeaten run and push for the play-offs.

HISTORY - TUNBRIDGE WELLS



Senior football has been played in Tunbridge Wells since 1886 although the Club has had different names.

Tunbridge Wells Wanderers might be the best, though an unused, name as ten different grounds have been used around the town. The post war years, however, saw the club almost entirely based either at the present Culverden Stadium or at Eridge Road on what is now the Showfields Estate.

In its heyday Tunbridge Wells played regularly in front of four-figure crowds and were a significant force in non-league football. The 1930's in particular were heady days when long cup runs were almost expected by supporters and Football League opposition was not unusual in the FA Cup.

Tunbridge Wells Rangers' first Kent League fixture took place in 1903. Before World War II, the club also competed in the London Combination and Southern Leagues. After the war the Wells briefly resumed playing as an amateur club although success and a return to semi-professional status were not far around the corner.

In 1954-55 the club once more progressed to the FA Cup first round proper before being

comprehensively beaten by Brighton. Honours in this season included a unique treble of Kent Senior Cup, Kent Senior Shield and Kent League Cup.

After five seasons in the bottom four of the Southern League, the club duly collapsed at the end of the 1966-67 season and it was left to the determination of supporters to see the present day club formed. They entered the Kent Premier League and by the next year the team finished as Kent League runners up. The Wells won the Kent League championship in 1985 and have also won the Kent League Cup four times since the club's reformation.

On 31st August 2005 Tunbridge Wells made European football history by winning the longest penalty shoot-out for a senior cup match. 40 spot kicks were taken with the Wells triumphant 16-15 over Littlehampton Town in the FA Cup.

In 2009 Martin Larkin was appointed manager and in 2012-2013, secured the Kent Senior Trophy, the first trophy for 25 years, and memorably reached the final of the FA Vase at Wembley.

During the summer of 2015, Larkin resigned from his post due to work commitments which led to Jason Bourne being promoted from

long standing player to first team manager.

At the end of the 2018-19 season we had a managerial change with Richard Styles joining us as 1st team manager from fellow SCEFL Premier League side Lordswood. Richard's first two seasons were cut short and the season not completed due to Covid, his one full season in charge saw the club finish in 8th place and reach the quarter finals of the FA Vase. At the end of 2021-22 season it was mutually agreed that Richard would leave the club along with his coaching staff.

A new Management Team was appointed for the 2022-23 season

with Luke Carpenter appointed as First Team Manager and Steve Ives Assistant Manager, at the close of the season Steve Ives departed taking up the Managers role at Uckfield FC in the Southern Counties Premier League.

Ten days before the start of the new season Luke Carpenter our Manager resigned, so it was an easy decision to appoint Steve Ives as our Manager for the 2023/24 season with a backroom staff of Stephen Harper, Assistant Manager, Jon Shea as Coach and Adam Porter as Goalkeeping Coach.

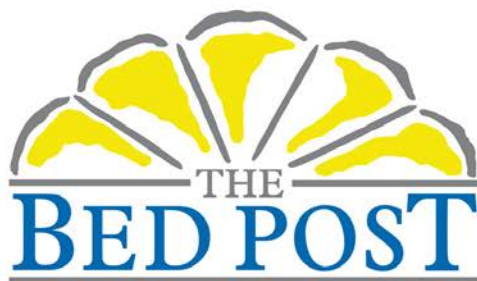

A last minute penalty denied Welling Town a famous victory at Glebe on Saturday.

Sam Bailey had given the Boots a 27th minute lead, and they looked like holding on before Ali Fofanah's spot-kick rescued a point for the League leaders.

Corinthian failed to close the gap after going down 2-0 at Punjab United.

Steve Ratcliff put Punjab ahead in the 2nd minute and Paul Vines settled it in the 87th.

Deal Town did close the gap with a 2-1 win at Sutton Athletic.

They also had to wait for the 87th minute to win it through Jack Penny's penalty.

Aaron Millbank's goal on the stroke of half-time put Deal ahead, before Daniel Emmanuel levelled early in the second half.

Wins for Lydd Town and Snodland Town boosted their play-off hopes.

Ryan Smith scored Lydd's 90th minute winner after they twice lost the lead in a 3-2 win at home to Stansfeld.

Luke Burdon opened the scoring with a 38th minute penalty, only for Tommy Whitnell to level five minutes later.

Burdon restored the lead eleven minutes after the break, but Sam Jeal

looked like earning Stansfeld a point when he equalised six minutes from time.

Jack Nelson and Francis Babalola netted for Snodland Town in a 2-0 win at Rusthall.

Fisher bagged four for the second time in a week as they beat Hollands & Blair 4-2.

Thomas Ngegba scored either side of Devonte West's goal to give the Fish a half-time lead.

Billy Brown and Nathan Tshola put the game out of reach before Rob Denness' late consolation.

VCD Athletic also won 4-2 away to Lordswood.

Lordswood lead through Den Chandler at half-time, but Charlie Heatley and Richard Jimoh put Vickers ahead.

An own goal levelled matters before Eni Amgbaduba and Lee Bird won the game in a five minute spell.

Will Johnson-Cole scored an 80th minute penalty in Bearsted's 1-1 draw at home to Holmesdale, who had lead courtesy of Wale Odedoyin's effort.

Whitstable Town and Tunbridge Wells drew a blank at Belmont Road.
