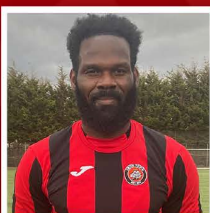

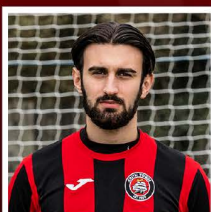

Ladic Melconian missed the game with a groin injury, while Joe Chalker is likely to be out for a number of weeks after injuring himself in an accident.

We now lose James for three games as well, so the importance of depth in the squad is already being underlined.

Next weekend we take on Loxwood in the FA Vase, with our home tie being played at Corinthian's Gay Dawn Farm ground in Fawkham.

We then return here in two weeks time to play Kennington in the League.

Shae Echema scored the only goal as Bearsted beat Kennington 1-0 at White Post Lane.

LORDSWOOD and K Sports looked set for a goalless draw before Richard Jimoh's 87th minute strike took the points back to Ditton.

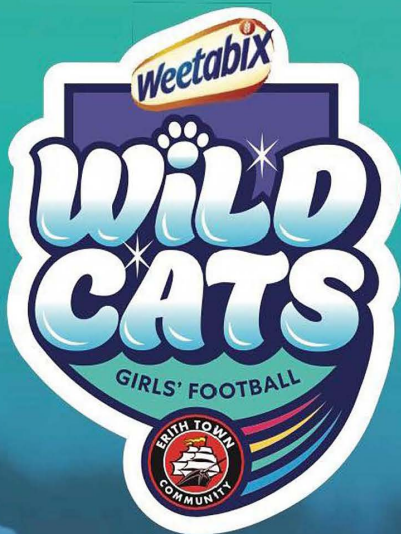
Welling Town ended STANSFELD'S winning start with a 2-1 win at Foxbury Avenue.

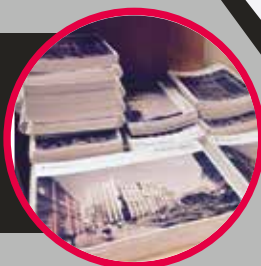

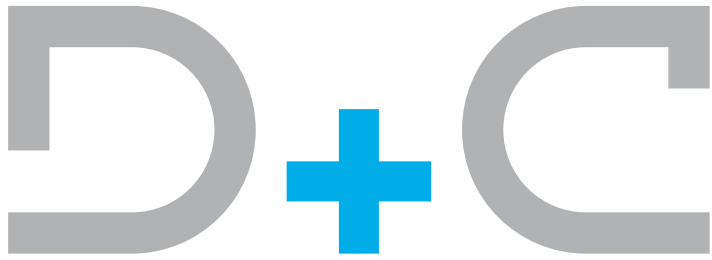
