HISTORY - LANCING FC



he club was established in 1941, initially as a multi-sport club under the name Lancing Athletic. They joined the Brighton, Hove & District League in 1946 and went on to win the Division One and League Cup double in their first season. The club applied to join the Sussex County League, but were rejected. However, after retaining the Brighton, Hove & District League title in 1947-48, the club were then admitted to the Sussex County League, at which point they became a separate organisation to the remainder of the sports club. They were Sussex County League runners-up in 1949-50, only missing out on the title on goal average. When the league gained a second division in 1952 the club became members of Division One, but were relegated to Division Two after finishing bottom of the table in 1956-57.

In 1957 the club dropped Athletic from their name. They were Division Two champions at the first attempt, earning promotion back to Division One. The club won the League Cup in 1964–65, beating Chichester City 2–0 in the final, and went on to win the Sussex RUR Cup the following season with a 3–0 win over Rye United. However, they were relegated again at the end of the 1967–68. Although the club won the Division Two title in 1969–70 and were promoted back to Division One, two seasons later they were relegated back to Division Two after finishing bottom of Division One. The club won the Division Two Cup in 1981–82.

Lancing remained in Division Two until a second-place finish in 1982–83 saw them promoted to Division One. They were relegated again at the end of the 1989–90 season and spent the next ten seasons in Division Two, winning the Division Two Cup again in 1992–93, before earning promotion with a third-place finish in 1999–2000. However, the club were relegated

back to Division Two at the end of the following season. In 2010–11 they were Division Two runners-up, earning promotion to Division One. In 2015 the league was renamed the Southern Combination, with Division One becoming the Premier Division.

In the 2017/18 season, first team manager Jon Sharman, assisted by Nigel Geary & Malcolm Saunders, led the Lancers to 10th place in the Southern Combination Premier League. At the end of the season, Chairman, Jon Rea, resigned from his role, in addition to Jon Sharman and Nigel Geary.

For the 2018/19 season, Steve Taylor was elected Chairman to replace the departing Jon Rea, and was joined by Daniel Fuller-Smith as Secretary, whilst Barry Sutton was promoted to the role of Vice-Chairman. With 4 new teams – Ladies, two Under-18 squads and a Veterans side – joining the existing First Team and Under-23s, the club gained FA Charter Standard Community status in February 2019. Unfortunately Ash Bailey was forced to retire from his post as First Team manager in September for family commitments, and was replaced by Mark Pulling who enabled the team to finish 13th in the SCFL Premier Division table.

In the 2019/20 season, the club introduced a new Disability team, and appointed a new First Team management team, consisting of Naim Rouane, David Altendorff and Kane Louis for the season. The first team had an excellent season, the best in the club's history, however the season was brought to a premature end following the COVID-19 outbreak. The Lancers were top of the league looking to be promoted, but with the season voided by the FA, were left to compete in the SCFL for another season.

Following a second curtailed season due to COVID-19, thanks to FA restructuring, Lancing were promoted to the Pitching In Isthmian League – South East Division, finishing top on PPG in the SCFL Premier Division over the course of two seasons. This movement from Step 5 to Step 4 in the English football pyramid marked a huge achievement for the club, in what was appropriately also their 80th anniversary.

Now competing at Step 4 the Club escaped relegation in their first season by beating Newhaven 2-1 in a Play Off final at Culver Road after they finished 3rd bottom. The following season saw the Club consolidate its position in the League with the experienced Dean Cox taking over the reins. Cox came to the Club having made over 300 appearances with League Clubs Brighton & Hove Albion, Leyton Orient and Crawley Town. However, after a brief spell Cox and his management team left for Burgess Hill Town just after the season ended having guided the Club to safety. The Club again wasted little time in finding a replacement and appointed David Altendoff who had previously been the Club's assistant manager before Covid interrupted proceedings back in 2020. He built a new squad that saw the Club enjoy their best ever season and narrowly missing

out on a play-off place. However, in the close season Altendoff left the Club to become Assistant manager at Whitehawk and a mass exodus of first team players followed. The Club appointed club coach Jamie Hollis as the new manager and with his assistant Phil Norman they spent the summer completely rebuilding the squad and hopes were high that the Club could go one step further this season and get into the play-offs.

After a disappointing start to the new season a poor run of results saw the Club reluctantly part company with Jamie Hollis and his assistant Phil Norman and the Club handed the reins over to Sam Morgan, Sam had previously been manager at Epsom & Ewell and Sutton Common Rovers, who he took to their highest ever position last season, as well as being the Assistant Manager at Haywards Heath Town for a spell. However, after a disappointing run of results that has seen the Club drop into the bottom four the Club made the difficult decision to release Sam and his backroom staff and have now appointed Billy Wood who was manager of AFC Uckfield in Division 1 of the Southern Combination League who has been tasked with retaining their Isthmian League status.

ISTHMIAN ROUND-UP



A full set of fixtures on Bank Holiday Monday confirmed all the ups and downs before going into the last day of the season.

A humdinger of a match in front of 516 at Homelands Stadium as Ashford United beat Hythe Town 5-3. An 8th minute penalty for the visitors was dispatched by Javaun Splatt but the lead lasted just one minute when Michael West brought the home side level. Things seemed to be going to plan for The Cannons when Ellis Brown restored their lead on 21' and Splatt bagged his brace on 27', but once again only a single minute passed before Louis Collins got one back for The Nuts & Bolts on 28' and it only took until 41' for Gary Lockyer to restore parity. After the break Lockyer got his brace on 51' to give them the lead for the first time in the game and eventually Louis Collins rounded things off with Ashford's fifth on 88' confirming relegation for Hythe.

Beckenham Town took a two goal lead into the break against Erith Town at Eden Park Avenue courtesy of Alfie Bloomfield on 13' and then again on 33'. A second half goal from Sam Wood on 70' capped things off for the 240 in attendance as Becks ran out 3-0 winners.

Broadbridge Heath put Littlehampton Town to the sword with a 4-0 win in front of 205 at The BodyMould Mattresses Stadium. Mark Goldson got the opener with a 28th minute penalty and followed that up with his second on 36'. Three minutes later Mason Doughty got their 3rd and after the break Louis Evans joined in with the fourth on 65'.

Ditto Burgess Hill Town playing hosts to Three Bridges in front of 883 at The Homecall Carpets Community Stadium and putting four past them for no reply. Harry Lawson opened the scoring on 8' while Stefan Vukojie got the first of his brace on 37' and the second after the break on 55' leaving Lawson to grab his second and Hillians' fourth on 79'.

At the Vistavis Community Stadium, 161 watched on as home side East Grinstead Town went down 1-3 to visitors Eastbourne Town. The Wasps went ahead on 12' when Harrison Parker opened the scoring, but a mad three minutes saw Nathan Hover get The Town level on 33' followed by a brace from James Ding on 34' and 35'.

729 souls at the Crest Stadium watched on as hosts Herne Bay were beaten 0-3 by Deal Town. Two first half goals from Wes Hennessey [19') and Tom Chapman (38') were capped off by a late Archie Hatcher goal on 90+4'.

Lancing played out a 1-1 draw with fellow relegated team Steyning Town Community in front of 228 at Culver Road. Callum Brandon Erskine put The Lancers ahead after only 8 minutes, but Ollie Rawlins brought the Barrowmen level on 39° and that's how it stayed.

Sevenoaks Town managed a creditable 2-2 draw against hosts Merstham at the Hybrid Fitness Stadium, 551 looked on as Korrey Henry put the Moatsiders ahead on 24' and it stayed that way until half time. The second half went the way of the visitors with Warren-Hughes Mfula equalising on 55' followed quickly by Thomas Hanfrey putting The Oaks ahead on 58'. Merstham left it late but Seanan McKillop bagged their second on 82' with both sides going home honours even.

Phoenix Sports snatched a win at Mayplace Road East, beating AFC Croydon Athletic 2-1. The opener came from Jerson Dos Santos only 13 minutes in but Nya Kirby levelled for Croydon on 22'. Ahkeem Belford grabbed the winner on 73' but it was too little too late for the 130 in attendance as Phoenix became the final side to be confirmed as relegated.

Ramsgate, and the 3,300 faithful at Southwood Stadium, were probably still reeling from their celebrations after being crowned Champions, explaining their 1-4 beating by Margate. Max Walsh opened for The Gate on 18' with Louie Atkins adding one on 44'. Josh Ajayi pulled one back for The Rams right on half time but Tushaun Walters (58') and Ben Allen (90+6') put the tie out of site.

Finally, Sheppey United saw out a 0-0 with Sittingbourne in front of 992 at Holm Park who probably thought they deserved more fun on a holiday weekend.






