With that said, we would like to extend a warm welcome to the players and staff of Sevenoaks, to their travelling fanbase and to the club committee and volunteers who work hard behind the scenes. We'd also like to welcome the third team on the pitch today, the match day officials, have a good day and hope all three teams put on a performance for those in attendance at the Stanmore Stadium.

Looking at the form of both clubs and score lines over the season, there are always goals whenever these two sides are in action, which makes it ironic that one of the very few 0-0 results Erith Town have had in recent seasons were when The Dockers and Sevenoaks met last October. Since then, it has been a rollercoaster of emotions for both sets of fans, and the two teams now find themselves comfortably in mid-table on 40 points, knowing only one or two more wins from their remaining games will make them mathematically safe and

playing tier four football again next season.

Three of Erith Town's points came last weekend at fellow SCEFL 2023/24 promotion side, Deal Town. The Charles Ground has not been the happiest of hunting grounds for Adam Woodward's men over the past couple of years, but a mature and dedicated performance from our side, and a shout out to midfield maestro, James Miles who made Kent Online Team of the Week, saw the Dockers record a fantastic 3-1 away win and complete a league double over our friends on the coast. We'd also like to give The Hoops a shout out for creating a chant for our club podcast, The Dockers Debate and hope that we hear similar around the rest of the grounds when we travel away for the rest of this campaign.

Back to today's game, your support for our side continues to be the envy of many of those in the league, and the atmosphere that The Dockers Faithful create is something that really does inspire us when we need to dig deep in those final few moments of a game. Keep bringing your fantastic support to today's fixture, and enjoy the game.

# HISTORY - SEVENOAKS TOWN

Sevenoaks Town FC was originally formed in 1883 and they were founder members of the original Kent League, but they left after just one season and wouldn't return for another 110 years. There are few existing records of the club during that era, but it is known that on 26 April 1893 they played Royal Arsenal, who were at the time the only professional team in the South of England, with over 1,000 spectators watching the game.

In 1906 the club, now known as Sevenoaks Town, became one of the founder members of the Sevenoaks League. In 1951 Town amalgamated with another local club, St. John's United, and became members of the Kent Amateur League (Western Region), which they won on two occasions. In 1984 the Kent Amateur League was re-organised as the Kent County League and Sevenoaks were the first Premier Division champions, a feat they repeated in seasons 1995/96 and 2002/03. After over a century playing in almost exclusively amateur leagues, Sevenoaks applied for promotion to the semi-professional Kent League after winning the 02/03 title. Their first season in the county's senior league ended with a respectable 11th place and included a memorable victory away to former Football League side Maidstone United, when they recovered from a 3-1 half-time deficit to win 4-3.

The move to senior level also meant Sevenoaks were eligible for FA competitions. Their first appearance in the FA Vase came in 2004/05, when they lost 2-1 at home to Deal Town. Their longest run in the competition came in the final season they were eligible, 2017/18, when they made it to the third round proper before losing 3-1 away to Thatcham Town.

Since achieving promotion to the Isthmian League, Town have switched to the FA Trophy.

In their first ever match in the competition in 2018/19 they beat former Conference side Grays Athletic 4-2 before losing 2-1 away to Dorking Wanderers, who went on to win the Isthmian Premier Division, in the first qualifying round.

In the FA Cup Town's best performance came in 2016/17 when they took Chesham to a replay in the second qualifying round, and although they've yet to meet Football League opposition, one of their most memorable ties came in 2008/09 when they held Folkestone Invicta to a 4-4 draw at Greatness Park in the preliminary round. Town led 2-0 and 3-2 but were trailing 4-3 in stoppage time when a free-kick from Dwayne Gibbons earned them a replay, which they eventually lost 4-1.

After a decade during which their highest league position was sixth in 2009/10, Town appointed the former Dartford and Tonbridge player Micky Collins as manager for the 2014/15 season. Having previously won the Kent League title with Erith & Belvedere, Collins oversaw four seasons of progress, which saw the club rise from 16th to eighth, fifth and third in 2016/17, a season which also saw them win the Premier Division Cup. In 2017/18, having installed a 3G pitch, Collins led them to win the Southern Counties East League title and promotion to Step 4 football for the first time in the club's history.

A 10th place finish in their first season in Isthmian League South East proved an impressive start. Two Covid interrupted campaigns followed - last season proved a difficult one - a poor run of results ending with the departure of Collins following a 4-0 defeat at Ashford United in mid February, after seven and a half seasons in charge. Harry Hudson was appointed two weeks later - with 10 games left - a host of new players featuring in

his first match in charge, earning a 1-1 draw at Corinthian. A point was a good enough start with an almost completely new side, but nobody could have predicted the dramatic transformation in the team's fortunes - from relegation candidates to mid-table finishers - in the remaining two months of the season, completed with a 2-1 final day win at champions Hastings United. A seventh successive victory clinched 13th place, winning 26 points out of a possible 30, putting them top of the form table, with Hudson named Manager of the Month for April.

The 2022/23 season saw the club record their best ever runs in the Emirates FA Cup and Isuzu FA Trophy. The FA Cup highlight was the 1-0 win in the third qualifying round at National League South Bath City, before going out to eventual champions Ebbsfleet United - pushing them all the way, before losing 2-0. The Trophy exit a week earlier followed a 1-0 defeat at Lewes. Eighth place in Pitching In Isthmian South East was also the best finish as a Step 4 club.

The 2023/24 season saw Sevenoaks finish 10th - inconsistent results after a promising start seeing them feature in a congested mid-table

with only five points separating as many as six clubs. Reaching the quarter-finals in the DFDS Kent Senior Cup was one highlight after disappointing early exits in the FA Cup and FA Trophy. The club said farewell to two managers - Harry Hudson left in October, replaced by his No.2 Mark Dacey who stepped down for personal reasons.

Marcel Nimani was appointed in June with the task of rebuilding the squad with only two players remaining from last season. A reserve team has been re-introduced, managed by Steve McGinn, to play in the Sevenoaks League Premier Division.

The club's women's teams continue to progress in their respective competitions as well as success for many of the club's junior teams - boys and girls - and Powerchair - Gregg Baxter selected for the England Development Squad, scoring a hat-trick against Spain.

Funding was confirmed to finance the long term project of redeveloping Greatness Park. The strength of the club is highlighted by these figures - a total 1299 players, 234 volunteers and nearly 90 sponsors.

# ISTHMIAN ROUND-UP



There were just the five midweek games in the Isthmian South East this week but as usual we'll round up what went on right here for you.

Surprising absolutely none of the 212 in attendance at The Bodymould Mattresses Stadium, hosts **Broadbridge Heath** were soundly beaten 1-5 by visitors **Ramsgate**. The Bears must've thought they were in for a good night when **Callum Dowdell** opened the scoring on 15 minutes, but the Rams must have taken umbridge at their sheer audacity because it took just four minutes for **Tijan Jadama** to give Ramsgate parity, followed only two minutes later by **Joe Taylor** giving them the lead, then five minutes after that **Jay Leader** made sure the Rams went in comfortably ahead at the break. They weren't done however, as **Alfie Paxman** hit their fourth on 76' and **Kai Garrett** got in on the act on 90+3' by supplying the fifth to round off another barnstormer of a night for Ramsgate that saw all 3 points heading, as expected, down to the coast.

Meanwhile at the Homecall Carpets Community Stadium, **Burgess Hill Town** left it late to secure the points against **AFC Croydon Athletic**, with **Martyn Box** stepping up to hit a penalty home in the 86th minute and send the crowd of 274 home happy.

**East Grinstead Town** got off to a flyer against **Sheppey United** when **Matthew**

**Daniel** put them in front on five minutes. The lites weren't lying down though and they got back in the game when **Jay Taylor** levelled on 38'. It stayed that way until after the break when **Kieran Humpherston** put The Wasps back in front in the 53rd minute and it stayed that way until full time, sending the 96 die-hards home from the Vistavis Community Stadium with a spring in their step.

High-flying **Merstham** saw off relegation candidates **Hythe Town** with a neat 2-1 win at the Hybrid Fitness Stadium. 313 hardy souls braved the freezing weather to watch **David Ozobia** put Hythe Town ahead on 18' but The Moatsiders got back into the game with a 37th minute finish from **Korrey Henry**, and then edged in front right before half-time from **Charlie Greenwood** (45+3').

A tremendous night for **Sittingbourne** at the Staxson Stadium where 414 saw them dismiss fellow title chasers Margate 3-0. **Troy Howard** got The Brickies off to a great start after only nine minutes and it only took until 37' for **Donvieve Jones** to double their advantage making the half-time team talk an easier affair. It stayed that way right until the ninetieth when **Henry Sinai** made it safe and sure sending the Gate back up the coast empty handed.
