# WELCOME - SITTINGBOURNE

Good afternoon all and welcome to the Stanmore Stadium for today's game with high-flying Sittingbourne FC, and a warm welcome to the First Team and Management of The Brickies, as well as all committee members and volunteers to SE28 from The Staxson Stadium, and finally to today's match officials. We hope that we are treated to a great game, played in the right spirit for all those in attendance.

Unfortunately, due to Mother Nature playing havoc with pitches around the country, this is the first game we have had since the away defeat at Ashford United on the 28th of December last year. The local derby away at Phoenix Sports on New Year's Day failed a pitch inspection as did the home game with Herne Bay, and today is the start of a very tough run of games that are coming up for Adam Woodward's side.

There's plenty to play for this season and our next five games have us facing off with sides either right in the promotion charge, or those desperate to fight the drop back down to the fifth tier, so there is no mid-table mediocrity on the horizon for Erith Town and anyone else associated with us. Your support has been fantastic this

season, with attendances well in the three figures and our following on and off the pitch growing at a rapid pace, but it is vital over the next few weeks that we get the Stanmore packed and raise an atmosphere that will get those in the red and black pumped up and giving everything for this club.

This is the second meeting of the two sides this season, with The Dockers securing a 4-1 victory over Sittingbourne in the Velocity Cup back in September. Since then, both sides have had great runs of form, but Sittingbourne have been like a runaway train and are scoring goals for fun.

Whilst The Dockers find themselves in a respectable 10th place in their maiden Isthmian South-East campaign, Sittingbourne are on the push for automatic promotion and are sitting comfortably in second place, seven points clear of third place Margate, with a game in hand on the Jolly Boys, and just two points behind league leaders Ramsgate.

We hope you enjoy today's game, keep bringing the noise and get behind the side from the first whistle.

# HISTORY - SITTINGBOURNE FC

The club began as Sittingbourne United back in 1881 but In 1886 it became Sittingbourne Football Club, playing at the Bull Ground in the centre of town. In 1892 the club gained senior status and won its first major title in 1897/98 with the Kent League, and the Kent Senior Cup followed in 1902.

After the First World War came more senior cup and league titles. The club also enjoyed the first of three successful spells in the Southern League, twice narrowly missing promotion to the Premier Division on just goal average. The club reached the first-round proper of the F.A Cup in 1962 but lost 3-0 at Hinckley Athletic, but continued to be one of the strongest teams in the Kent League throughout the 1970s and 1980s.

The move to Central Park in February 1990 brought more success on the pitch when, in their first season, they won the Winstonlead Kent League without losing a game - the only senior football team throughout Europe to achieve that feat in the 1990/91 season.

Promotion to the Beazer Homes Southern League followed with the championship of the Southern Division secured in 1993 followed by promotion to highest level achieved by the club since it's foundation in 1881. The ground record was broken five

times during that one season with 5,951 spectators watching a friendly with Spurs and more than 3,000 at the match with local rivals Gravesend - a Beazer Homes Southern Division record. More money flowed in with the £21,000 sale of Neil Emblen and Mickey Harle to Millwall before the bubble spectacularly burst. Debts of more than £1 million were revealed, the team were relegated, the ground was closed for a while despite the intervention of the local council in taking it over, and the club was officially wound up.

Somehow Sittingbourne have survived it all and even got back to the Southern Premier Division during this traumatic time finishing an equal highest ever eighth before the financial problems again began to bite and relegation followed. A new management committee made great strides in tackling the debt problem and getting them back on an even keel financially. To ensure survival of the club, the decision was made to move out of the imposing main stadium and move to another pitch on the complex.

With The FA reorganising the leagues they faced a brand-new challenge playing a number of "unknown" teams in the Ryman Isthmian League for season 2006/07. During the 2009/10 season, they were in playoff contention for much of the time but ended with a creditable 9th place

finish, while for the first time in fifty years, they won the Kent Senior Cup in front of 618 at Folkstone Invicta.

For the 2013/14 season, Sittingbourne decided to leave their home of 10 years and accept an invitation to move to Woodstock Park a 14-acre area with superb social facilities. Andy Spice, who almost single handedly kept Sittingbourne as a senior club, stood down as Chairman making way for Maurice Dunk, a Director of the company that holds the leasehold for Woodstock Park. In February 2018 Manager, Nick Davis and Assistant Manager, Tony Cornwell resigned. Coach, Aslan Odev took over and after initially taking The Brickies to the play off places, lost momentum, and it was mutually agreed that he would stand aside, paving the way in January 2019, for Dover Athletic Academy development manager, Chris Lynch, to take over.

After a disappointing end to the now expunged 2019/20 season Chris Lynch

resigned to be replaced by his Assistant Darren Blackburn. Due to COVID restrictions, Darren's first full season was 2021/22 when the club had an early exit from both major cup competitions and finished mid-table in the league. An ill-fated run under returning manager Nick Davis ended in early January 2023 and the club brought in Ryan Maxwell to take his place. Ryan turned results around and the club garnered enough points to avoid relegation.

The 2023-24 season proved to be one of the best in recent times for Sittingbourne. They finished in third place but lost out in the play-offs when Three Bridges beat Sittingbourne at Woodstock Park in the semi finals. Ryan Maxwell has bought in a number of experienced players to make a real challenge on the league title this season so there is much excitement around Woodstock Park amongst the supporters.

# ISTHMIAN ROUND-UP



Due to the weather, there were only six games which took place in the Isthmian South-East Division last weekend.

The neutral at **Deal Town** would have been delighted that the game was on, but the home side must have been devastated to have scored three and walked away with nothing, as **Burgess Hill Town** were 5-3 victors at The Charles Sports Ground. It was a real back and forward game, but the three Deal goals from **Alfie Foster**, **Archie Hatcher** and **Morgan Page** just weren't enough to stop The Hillians leaving with the three points after goals from **Ben Pope** (2), **Stefan Vukojic** (2) and **Bobby Price**.

The game between **Eastbourne Town** and **Lancing** had a more recognisable score line, and it was home side who managed to secure the 2-1 win. Second half goals from **Nathan Hover** (2) for Eastbourne were hit with a 90th minute Lancing goal from **Charlie Gibson**, but it was too little too late for the visitors.

**Margate's** push for automatic promotion was dented with a 1-1 draw at home with **Merstham**. **Kai Garande's** goal took the lead early

in the second half and seemed to have made Margate victors, but a late strike **Aaron Jenkins** three minutes before time saw the Jolly Boys lose their dolphin and share the points with their Surrey opponents.

**Phoenix's** hopes of leaving the drop zone were also negatively impacted after they lost 2-0 away at **Sevenoaks Town**. Two second half goals from **Joshua Wisson** and **Warren-Hughes Mfula** kept the points at Greatness Park.

A side who gave their survival chance a boost was **Steaying Town Community**, who defeated **Ashford United** 3-2 at home. Goals from **Harvey Killick** (2) and **Lucas Murrain** gave Steaying a vital three points, but a brace from **Preston Kedwell** meant that this game was a nail-biting affair for all fans of the home side.

**Ramsgate** had the rare feat of not just finding the net five times in their 5-0 away win at **Three Bridges**, but there were five separate goal scorers. Strikes from **Josh Ajayi**, **Josh Hallard**, **Joe Taylor**, **Aaron Barnes** and **Jay Leader** saw The Rams remain top of the table, two points clear of second place Sittingbourne.
