# HISTORY - VCD ATHLETIC



VCD Athletic FC is one of only a few clubs to have originated during the Great War when, in 1916 it was formed by workers employed at the Vickers armaments factory in Crayford. The Company originally played only interdepartmental games until it was decided that the best players from the various sections would be elected to represent the firm. The club have played at the firm's sports ground, Oakwood, in Old Road, Crayford, from the outset right up to the present time.

Vickers (Erith) joined the re-formed Kent League in 1919, changing their name to Vickers (Crayford) a year later. In their first season in the Kent League they visited Maidstone United on Boxing Day and played in front of a crowd of 13,500.

The Vickers team that day contained seven Arsenal players who were finishing off their war service. It was a further 25 years before more silverware came their way, when they won the Kent Division One title in 1953. The Kent Amateur Cup was won in 1962 and in 1964 but the following season saw a spectacular slump and relegation, with a record of P24 W0 D2 L22, goals for 25, goals against 199.

In 1993, Martin Ford joined the club as manager and, in season 1995/1996 a unique cup treble was achieved with wins in the Kent Intermediate Shield, Kent County League Cup, and the Erith Hospitals Cup. Season 1996/1997 then saw the club win the Kent County Premier Division title for the first time in their history. Senior status was awarded that same year and a successful application was made to join the Kent League. The following season saw the club begin a ground-share with Thamesmead Town, finishing up in seventh place but also reaching the final of the Kent League Cup, where they lost 1-0 to Deal Town.

A season later the club beat Faversham Town 4-0 in the final to bring the club a first ever senior trophy, and the year after that the club made its third consecutive cup final appearance when they reached the final of the

Kent Senior Trophy losing 10-9 on penalties to Whitstable Town.

The club eventually spent five seasons as tenants of Thamesmead Town before Lordswood FC kindly took their place for two seasons. Then the club embarked on a one year term with near neighbours Greenwich Borough. The club reached the final of the League Cup in 2002/2003, but were beaten 2-0 by Cray Wanderers. Further cup success followed in season 2005/2006 when the club reached the final of the Kent Senior Trophy for the second time, beating Tunbridge Wells 3-1 on penalties after a 1-1 draw.

During 2005 permission for floodlights and the development of the Oakwood ground was granted by Bexley Council. This enabled work to commence early in 2006. The pitch was levelled, rotated 90 degrees and re-laid. At the end of the 2007 season Martin Ford resigned as manager. Head coach Dean Frost took over as caretaker manager, and under his guidance the club obtained runners up spot in the league, narrowly missing out to Whitstable Town.

The following season Paul Foley was appointed manager of the first team, with Dean Frost reverting to his former position of head coach. Under their stewardship the club finished runners up once more. A year later, the club finally won the Kent League Premier Division title together with the Kent Senior Trophy, culminating in the long awaited promotion to the Ryman Football League at Step 4.

The first season was a success with an 8th place finish, but the club were left stunned when the Ryman League deemed ground issues warranted demotion. Midway through season 2012/2013 Ricky Bennett left the club due to outside pressures, and in his place the club secured the services of Tony Russell, and a magnificent record breaking run of 17 victories and 2 draws in the last 19 league fixtures enabled the club to gain promotion to the Ryman Football League Division One North.

Starting as favourites for relegation, the club had a stunning run, winning the first 15 games and heading the table for all but a couple of weeks throughout the campaign, and on the last day of the season, sitting in 2nd place the Vickers defeated Romford FC 6-0 while leaders Witham Town could only draw their last game which saw them secure the title by a point, taking the club to the Premier Division at Step 3, its highest ever level in the pyramid.

The club struggled for a lot of the next season, but won the last 6 games to finish in 18th position to maintain their place in the division. Manager Tony Russell immediately resigned, joining Cray Wanderers FC in Division 1 and taking his entire side with him, but the club acted quickly to secure the services of Keith McMahon as new First Team Manager. Keith came with no players at the club and only a few weeks to the start of the 2015/2016 season. He worked tirelessly and brought in some excellent players, but despite some good performances they were unable to find the consistency needed in the Premier Division and were relegated back to Division One (North). A switch to the South Division was sensible and saw Keith lead them to some solid finishes over the next few campaigns.

Ahead of the 2020/21 season Nick Davis was appointed as the new manager but his first season in charge was cut short due to the Covid pandemic, with VCD sitting proudly in a play off place. In the next year

they finished 9th before Former VCD favourite Grant Basey was appointed, bringing with him former player Michael Power as his assistant, but Grant resigned near the end of the season with Michael taking over the reigns, and after a struggle we were unable to put a sustained run together resulting in our relegation to the SCEFL Premier Division after losing narrowly in a play off. Michael Power was released at the end of that season and the club quickly appointed Danny Joy and Ross Baker as joint managers, who took on the unenviable task of quickly getting together a new team. This gave us a lot of problems with an unsettled side in the early months, but in the run in we put together a number of excellent performances with the squad looking very accomplished.

With a number of new signings, the hope for the following season was to carry this on and push even further to make a serious challenge for the play off spots. Expectations were exceeded however when we spent the entire season occupying one of the top two league positions, finally conceding the title to Faversham Town. The lottery of the play-offs beckoned but we held our nerve, beating Punjab United 2-0 in the semi final, and then Fisher 2-1 in the final to clinch promotion back to the Isthmian League South East Division.

Under Danny Joy and Ross Baker's stewardship the club now looks to establish itself back at Step 4.

**I**N A WEEK remembered for sudden managerial dismissals - Maresca at Chelsea, Amorim at Man Utd, Nancy at Celtic - it's somewhat refreshing to hear Alan Dowson talk so enthusiastically after celebrating his 1,000th game in the dugout. The shelf-life of a football manager may be as perilous as ever, but Dowson has a sell-by-date far longer-reaching.

The amiable Geordie has recently returned for a second spell in charge of Hampton & Richmond Borough where he enjoyed some of his most successful times in a management career that began at Walton & Hersham and also took in Kingstonian and Woking. Hampton's 2-0 win over Farnborough on Boxing Day marked Dowson's 1,000th game in the dug-out, and the 55-year-old told The NLP that he simply can't get enough of the management madhouse.

"It's f\*\*\*\*\*g brilliant! I haven't slept for two weeks," he told us in his unmistakable, and unrivalled, jovial spirit. "I don't see the missus anymore, or the kids. I went in the other night and I think they thought I was burgling the house!"

"It's great. Four o'clock in the morning and I'm blinking up. I am nervous, I've got anxiety again, it's excellent. I love pressure. I love everything about the game. Anxiety, pressure, nerves, happiness. On Monday I was driving two hours to watch Chelmsford against Dagenham. It's keeping me on the ball all the time."

And Dowson is not the only manager to have caught the bug. Back in November, NLP columnist Tony Incenzo told how Pep Guardiola's 1,000th game in management paled into insignificance compared to Ramsbottom United boss Steve Wilkes for example.

An emphatic 8-0 victory at City of Liverpool in the North West Counties League Premier Division was the Preston-base boss' 1,300th game in the dugout having started in August 1997. Explaining an astonishing story of dedication amidst work and family pressures, Wilkes said: "I'm really proud to hit the 1,300 mark. I've done 28 and a half years now and it is quite a milestone.

"I started out as a manager in the summer of 1997. I had been playing for Darwen when I received a phone call stating the boss was leaving and asking if I could fill the vacancy. I was only 29 and it didn't interest me at all. I had never wanted to go into management or coaching. Even so, Darwen asked me to consider it.

"I was friendly with Sam Allardyce from my professional playing days. I had previously been at Preston while he was at Bolton. So I gave Sam a ring for advice. He said: 'Look mate, take the position. Do it for six weeks. If you

don't enjoy it, you can quit."

Seven years at Darwen, voluntarily and without a budget, proceeded a five-and-a-half year stint with Padiham before Wilkes joined Runcorn Linnets, where he was sacked for the only time in his career after two-and-a-half years. Twelve months at Ashton Athletic led to him re-joining Padiham in 2012/13 where Wilkes won the North West Counties League title and enjoy a couple of seasons in the Northern Premier League.

Following another five-year stint, he then left the Storks and moved to Northwich Victoria and after leading the club to the FA Vase semi-final, Wilkes, now a grandfather, decided to retire three years ago. That was until Ramsbottom United got back in touch.

"I spoke about it to my wife of 35 years Alison," he explained. "Her exact words were: 'Yes please! I don't want you under my feet on a Saturday!' So my retirement didn't last very long."

And talking of 1,000 games, it's not just the managers achieving extraordinary feats. Back in October, we sat down with 44-year-old Peter Clarke after making his landmark career appearance when turning out for Prescot Cables in their FA Trophy fixture with Lancaster City.

The former Everton youth defender enjoyed a remarkable career, turning out for the likes of Blackpool (two spells), Southend United, Huddersfield Town, Oldham Athletic and Tranmere over 100 times before enjoying a stellar Non-League career with two seasons at Warrington Town and now Cables after joining in the summer.

And only this week, he will be joined on an illustrious 55-man worldwide list - including that of Cristiano Ronaldo, Lionel Messi and littered with top Non-League names such as Paul Bastock, Barry Hayles and Scott McLeish - by veteran winger Kevin Ellison as he too celebrates his 1,000th senior game. This afternoon, at the age of 46, the Morecambe legend, who also turned out for the likes of Chester City, Rotherham and Tranmere, will reach the milestone playing for Vauxhall Motors against Runcorn Linnets in NPL West.

To mark the occasion, the Motormen are hosting a special celebration, including surprise guests and live entertainment with a big crowd expected. Players like Clarke and Ellison are a rarity in football as the elite list suggests, but are worth their weight in gold. More so, managers like Dowson and Wilkes who, as Maresca, Amorim, and Nancy will attest, are the first to carry the can when things don't quite go to plan.

Let's raise a glass to them all.

**J**anuary is in full-swing and so are all of those who are on the Dockers Pathway!

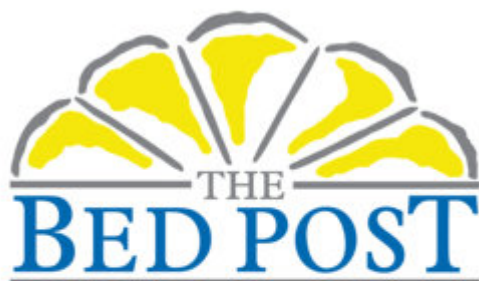

Although the results were mixed, we are still delighted with the effort and determination from our teams, and can't wait to see how the remainder of the season pans out!



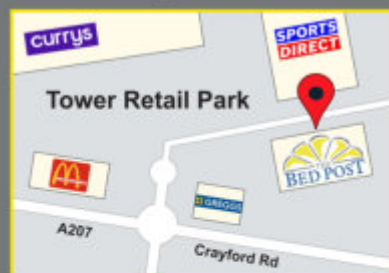
