# HISTORY - HASTINGS UNITED



The present Hastings United Football Club appears to have existed continuously since 1901 having undergone three changes of name. The origins of the club began with the founding of old town side Rock-A-Nore in 1894; however, five years later they became defunct but in 1901 a new club started-up using the same name. In April 1921 it was agreed to change the name to Hastings and St. Leonards Football Club.

Another name change to "Hastings Town" was passed in the 1960's, but then in June 1985, the already existing "Hastings United" ceased trading when they could no longer sustain their debts. Hastings Town made application to take over their Southern League place but Witney objected as United's demise had saved them from relegation from the Premier Division and, instead, Town were offered a place in the League's Southern Division. Several ex-United players joined Town and the unified side featured in the promotion race during their first two seasons but just missed out finishing third and fourth in 1986 and 1987, respectively.

Season 1998/99 saw an attempt to transfer to the Isthmian League refused but having resigned from the Southern League they were only accepted back as new entrants and started season 1999/2000 in the Eastern Division which they won in 2002. At this time the club finally acquired the company name Hastings United and since have played under that title.

Promoted to the Premier Division a twentieth position finish saw them make an immediate return to the Eastern Division but a first appearance was made in the F.A. Cup first round proper after winning a replay at Kettering Town. Sadly, there was to be no meeting with a Football League side to evoke memories of their namesake's glorious cup history, instead it was a visit to another Conference side, Stevenage Borough, where the dream ended with a 0-1 defeat. Relegation and the F.A.'s Non-League restructuring moved the side into the Ryman Isthmian League where they finished in eleventh and twelfth places in Division One in 2005 and 2006. Following a fourth place finish in

season 2006/07, promotion to the Premier Division was won by defeating second placed Tooting & Mitcham United in the end of season play-off final.

The 2009/10 season was United's most successful since gaining promotion. They looked likely to make the end of season play-offs until a late dip in form saw them finish seventh, but they did reach the semi-finals of the Sussex Senior Cup, losing to Brighton & Hove Albion.

Manager Tony Dolby left the club in December 2010 and was replaced by Jason Hopkinson. Results picked up and the club retained its Premier Division status. Jason left the Club during October 2011 following a disappointing start to the season and was replaced by central defender Sean Ray. United again found themselves in a relegation battle but managed to stay up. A poor league season in 2012/13 saw the club relegated from the Ryman League Premier Division, however, an FA Cup run saw United reach the third round proper before losing 4-1 away to Championship side Middlesbrough. They also reached the semi-finals of the League Cup, losing away to Concord Rangers, and the Sussex Senior Cup when they lost 1-0 to Bognor Regis Town.

Three days prior to the start of the new season, Sean Ray resigned and assistant Mark Stapley and coach Terry White took temporary charge, with John Maggs was appointed as manager towards the end of August 2013. John Maggs was dismissed towards the end of January 2014 and replaced by former player Terry White. Towards the end of season 2014/15 the club changed hands and a new board of directors was appointed. Garry Wilson was appointed as manager during the close season with Danny Bloor joining as assistant manager.

Garry Wilson and Danny Bloor stepped down at the end of the 2015/16 season to be replaced by former United player Darren Hare who had previously been with Gillingham FC in a number of rolls including caretaker manager. Darren rebuilt the squad during the close-season with a number of new signings. After

an excellent season which ended with a play-off semi-final defeat, on penalties, away to Dorking Wanderers, Darren Hare resigned. His replacement was Adam Hinshelwood who once again had to rebuild the side as a number of players moved on. Adam resigned during September 2017 to take on the managers role at Worthing FC and was replaced by his assistant Chris Agutter who remained at the helm on a full time basis until his resignation at the end of October 2021. November 2021 saw Gary Elphick appointed as Men's First Team manager with Andrew Brown as coach and Jon Meeney brought in to strengthen the coaching staff as Assistant Manager. Season 2021/22 see the 'U's achieve promotion by winning the Isthmian League South East Division and taking their place back at Step 3 for the first time since 2013.

Following an 8th place finish in the Isthmian Premier for 2022/23, missing the play-off spots by just three points and goal difference, the Club underwent an ownership and management change with Dean White becoming Club Chairman. Chris Agutter returned to the role of First Team manager towards the end of October 2023. Following a 7th place league finish and reaching the Final of the Sussex Transport Senior Cup, Agutter resigned to take up the vacant managers role of National League South Worthing FC.

Ahead of the 2024/25 campaign, the Club appointed Danny Bloor as First Team manager. He in turn appointed Sean Ray as his assistant. Following Bloor's departure last October, Sean took over as Caretaker Interim Manager. At the beginning of December 2024 Danny Searle was appointed as Men's First Team Manager. Danny Searle parted company with the club at the end of March 2025 with Dean White overseeing first team affairs, assisted by former club captain, Lee Carey, until the end of the season. The Club announced Lee Carey as new Men's First Team manager for the 2025/26 season on 20th May 2025. Following a difficult start to the 25/26 campaign, with the U's positioned second from bottom after six league encounters, Lee Carey stepped down as Men's First Team manager.

On October 23rd the Club appointed David Altendorff as the new Men's First Team Manager. David joins the U's having developed an impressive coaching career, progressing through roles at Newhaven and Loxwood before taking charge of Lancing in the Isthmian South East Division. During his time there, he guided the club to their highest-ever league finish, narrowly missing out on the playoffs. Most recently, David spent time at Whitehawk, first as Assistant Manager and then as Manager in the Isthmian League Premier Division. David will be joined by Alex Marr as his Assistant Coach.

FOOTBALL'S latest trend accessory, the micro shin pad, is going out of fashion faster than a John Barnes free-kick, it seems. As the name suggests, "micro" - or "mini" pads as they are also known - are modern-day shin guards that cover a smaller amount of the shin, about the size of a Custard Cream biscuit. But last week, we reported that a number of Step 5 and 6 clubs had imposed bans prohibiting their use following a horror injury suffered by young Ilfracombe Town winger Riley Malin.

Malin suffered a double leg break after coming off worse in a 50/50 challenge against Bridport, forcing their South West Peninsula League Premier East match to be abandoned. Micro shinpads were blamed and, as a result, the Bluebirds, along with Bridport and the likes of Bude Town and Dobwalls FC, announced that they implemented an immediate and non-negotiable ban on the use of micro shin pads across all age groups and squads. Ilfracombe said the decision had been made in the "interest of player safety and welfare", and to ensure that all players are "equipped with protective gear that meets required safety standards".

Showcased by Premier League stars such as Jack Grealish, the micro shinpad is now a popular item in dressing rooms up and down the country at amateur, grass roots and junior level. FA guidance for shin pads in community football states that such protection is a "compulsory" piece of equipment, but stops short of prohibiting micro versions. "The amount of shin physically covered is an important consideration, as any part of the shin that is not covered is not as well protected," the guidance says. "Micro' or 'Mini' shin pads may therefore increase the risk of injury due to the smaller amount of shin covered compared to larger sized shin pads."

Malin's injury proved the final straw for Ilfracombe, who said in a statement: "All players must wear regulation-sized, fully protective shin pads for all matches, training sessions, and club-sanctioned activities. "Any player found wearing micro shin pads - or any shin protection that does not meet accepted safety standards - will not be permitted to participate until compliant equipment is worn. "The incident at Bridport highlighted the unacceptable risk posed by inadequate protective equipment. The club has a duty of care to every player, and this measure is essential to maintaining safe and responsible playing conditions."

Their stance has been emulated by South West Peninsula League rivals Bude Town. They added: "This decision has been made to ensure player safety and welfare across all elements of competitive football, whether that be matches or training. "Players will not be able to play for Bude Town Football Club unless compliant equipment is worn and we need the co-operation from players, coaches and parents/guardians to enforce this decision."

Since our article, a number of other clubs have followed suit and also publicly come out in support of the ban. Isthmian South Central side Binfield said: "Following recent reviews of match-day equipment and reports within the press highlighting the ineffectiveness of micro shin pads, the club is introducing a full ban on micro shin pads, effective immediately. "Whilst we recognise that The FA has not yet put a ban in place to this effect, we at Binfield FC strongly believe that micro shin pads do not provide adequate protection and significantly increase the risk of injury. "To maintain a safe playing environment for all, all players must wear appropriately sized shin pads for training sessions and competitive fixtures. We ask all players, parents, and coaches to support this policy and ensure suitable equipment is worn at all times. "The club will continue to prioritise player welfare and appreciates your cooperation in upholding these standards.

And clubs at Step 7 are also taking a stance. Beaminster FC, who play in the Dorset Football League, said that their new shin pad policy was "a non-negotiable policy". "Managers/coaches and club officials present on the day will be asked to check that players are wearing appropriately sized shin guards that comply with this new policy," they said. "Failure to comply will result in the player being withdrawn from the fixture."

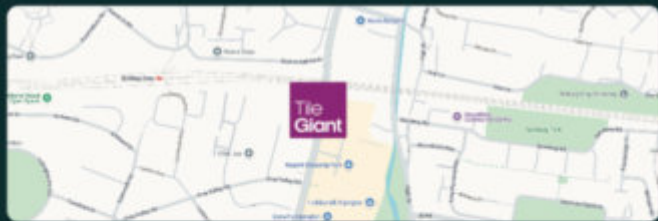
And Lyme Regis FC, who play in the Devon and Exeter Premier, added: "Player safety is our highest priority, and this policy reflects our commitment to ensuring a safe and responsible playing environment for everyone at the club." With Ilfracombe's stance gathering support all the time, don't be surprised others make a stand, thus forcing the relevant governing bodies into making a firmer decision in time.

Safety, not vanity must be the order of the day here and if a blanket ban prevents just one injury as suffered by Riley Malin then common sense will have prevailed.
