# HISTORY - HOLMESDALE



**H**olmesdale Football Club is a football club originally based in South Norwood, London. Affiliated to the Kent County F.A they are currently members of the Southern Counties East Football League Premier Division and play at Oakley Road in Bromley.

The original club was established as Holmesdale Baptists in the early 1920s and was affiliated with the Baptist Church on Holmesdale Road; players were church members and had to attend bible classes. They joined the Excelsior League, where they played for two seasons before joining Division Three of the Thornton Heath & District League for the 1922–23 season. Although they were Division Three runners-up in their first season, the club folded in 1923.

The club was reformed in 1956 by the 3rd East Surrey Boys Brigade Company and rejoined the Thornton Heath & District League in Division Six. They went on to win the division at the first attempt, earning promotion to Division Five. Another promotion in 1957–58 saw the club move up to Division Four, although they had to recruit players from another church club, which led to them dropping the word “Baptists” from the name. By 1960 the club had been promoted to Division Three.

In 1960–61 Holmesdale were Division Three runners-up, earning promotion to Division Two. The following season the club were Division Two champions and were promoted to Division One. The 1971–72 season saw the club win the Division title.

In 1986–87 they were Premier Division champions and were promoted to the Surrey Intermediate League. They were runners-up in Premier Division B in 1989–90, before winning the Surrey South Eastern Combination in 1992–93. The club were subsequently promoted to the Surrey Premier League. They won the league’s Charity Cup in 1993–94. In 2000 the club relocated to Bromley and switched to the Kent County League, joining Division One West.

The club played at Oaks Road in Shirley during their time in the Surrey Premier League, but were unable to install floodlights as the ground was owned by Croydon Council. As a result, they moved to Oakley Road in Bromley to gain promotion to the senior leagues, although three teams continued playing at Oaks Road, later breaking away to form Real Holmesdale Football Club in 2001.

In 2005–06 Holmesdale were Division One West champions, earning

promotion to the Premier Division. The following season saw them win the Premier Division title, resulting in promotion to the Kent League. The League was renamed the Southern Counties East League in 2013, and in 2015-16 the club finished bottom of the league, resulting in relegation to the newly formed First Division. 2016-17 saw Holmesdale finish in 6th place in the First Division and a Season later they ended in seventh place under the management of Tony Beckingham and Lee Roots. 2018/19 saw a few changes of management and a creditable 6th placed finish before Lee Roots returned for the 2019/20 campaign.

The 2019/20 and 2020/21 seasons

were disrupted due to Coronavirus but not before some excellent displays on the pitch put them in a promotion position, losing only 3 times in over 30 league games.

Fortunately, with the Non-League Restructure still taking place they were rewarded for their hard work over the previous 2 seasons with promotion into the Premier Division. The 2022-23 season was a bit of a disappointment as they just managed to avoid relegation, hopefully this season (2023-24) the new management and playing squad will turn their fortunes around and deliver a season of attractive football and positive results.

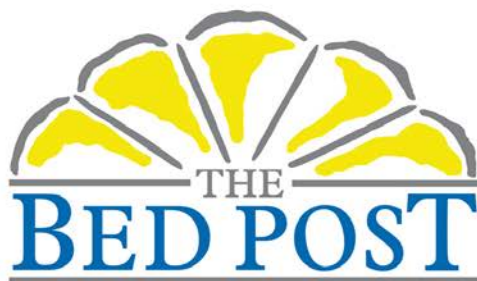

# SCEFL - ROUND-UP



**D**eal Town are closing in on the League title after beating leaders Glebe 4-2 on Saturday.

The win leaves Deal three points off top spot with seven games in hand, and also with five in hand on third placed Corinthian who are on the same points.

Ashley Miller, Billy Munday and Aaron Millbank scored in a nine minute blitz to put Steve King's side 4-2 up at the break. Alex Green sandwiched a fourth between goals from Jamie Coyle and Aaron Goode for the visitors in front of 1086 spectators.

Corinthian stayed in the hunt with a 2-1 win at Holmesdale. Jamie Billings and Michael Hagan scored for the Hoops before Alessio Akabuogo scored a late consolation.

Faversham Town look like having to settle for a play-off spot after a second successive draw. It started well for Tommy Warrilow's side as Billy Bennett and Sam Hasler put them 2-0 up inside thirteen minutes at home to Rusthall. Danny Powell and Jack Kirby scored either side of the break to draw Rusthall level before Faversham had three players sent off.

Lydd Town boosted their play-off chances with a 7-0 win at Welling Town. Five different players found the net before a late double from recent signing Jack Shonk.

Punjab United's chances took a blow in a 3-2 defeat at home to Lordswood. Mo

Dawodu's goal sent the Lords in ahead at half-time, but they had Luke Carey sent off early in the second half before Cruis Nyadzayo and Lea Dawson turned it around for Chipie Sian's men. Matt Gething levelled for the ten men and David Chandler completed their win two minutes into added time.

Bearsted dropped below Whitstable Town after they were held to a goalless draw at home to VCD Athletic.

Hollands & Blair are one of those with little to play for but had a comprehensive 4-0 win at Stansfeld.

Kennington look safer by the week, and shared the spoils of a 1-1 draw with Fisher at Homelands. Nathan Tshola gave the Fish a tenth minute lead, but Charlie Own levelled ten minutes into the second half.

Snodland Town may find an FA charge coming their way following the abandonment of their home match with Tunbridge Wells.

After having Robbie Bissett sin binned early in the second half, they then had four players sent off before the referee stopped the game.

The Laws of the game say that you can play on with seven players, but not six, although Bissett had returned by then according to reports.

The game was goalless when it was abandoned.

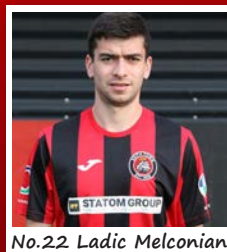

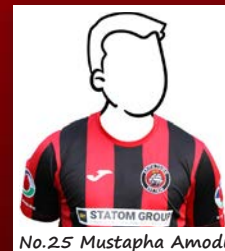
